

The Shippensburg Corn Festival provides funding from our profits each year to projects that meet the following criteria: ***To aid in funding historic preservation projects and/or the beautification and/or betterment of the community of Shippensburg.***

The final profit for the 2022 Shippensburg Corn Festival was \$13,744. Our profit each year is different. We give 50% of our profit out each year to applicants that meet our criteria. Regretfully, we can not fund every request that meets the criteria. The additional 50% is put into our project fund to use when higher amounts are needed for larger projects.
